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## **ABSTRACT**

This Mentorship can be part of the solution to developing a more diverse global scientific workforce, but mentorship models focused on dyadic mentoring can reproduce hierarchies the reinforce the status quo. Reframing mentoring relationships as developmental mentor networks can more accurately describe the experiences of protege, can deepen our understanding of how, why, and for whom mentoring "works," and can empower protege to effectively pursue their STEM career goals.
